

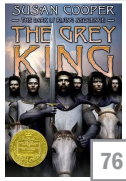

A millionaire's will requires his sixteen heirs to solve a puzzle before they can get their share of the estate.

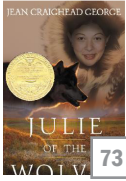

Will Stanton must fulfil a Welsh prophecy that would lead to the final battle between Dark and Light.

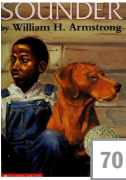

While surviving amidst a family of wolves, an Eskimo girl chooses between the old and new ways of living.

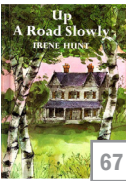

Karana is a Chumash girl who survives on an island the Pacific Ocean by herself. Based on a true story.

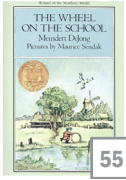

Jeff, a boy from Kansas, witnesses the American Civil War from both sides.

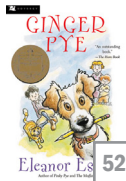

Dutch children seek to find out why swans no longer nest in their fishing village, and try to bring them back.

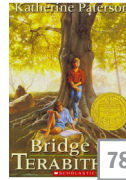

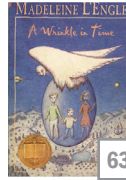

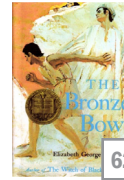

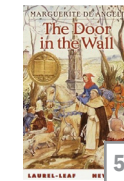
